



Safety Leaflet for Mono Fin and Tail Skin (Mermaid Tail)

Monofins are only recommended for age 6 and above and to be used by swimmers who can swim 25 metres comfortably and be able to do a full 360 degree turn in both directions with feet off the pool floor

- It is recommended that every mermaid is supervised by a human 'with legs' or has a 'buddy' when using the mermaid tail and that users stay close to the edge of the poolside for safety reasons
- Tails to be used in shallow water only until confident
- Whilst wearing the mermaid tail in the water in the upright position, keep knees soft and slightly bent to protect the mono fin
- Do not try to walk or jump in the mermaid tail on poolside
- Do not jump, shuffle forward or stand on the tip of the mono fin in the water or bend the mono fin in any way, as this could result in damage and the product being unusable
- To remove the mono fin and tail go into shallow water
- On purchasing a Mermaids UK mono fin and tail skin you are doing so at your own risk and Mermaids UK will take no responsibility for any accidents or incidents that incur whilst using both products either separately or together as a mermaid tail
- We advise you to check with your local pool before taking and using your mermaid tail and mono fin, ensuring that you are allowed to wear your tail in public sessions, alternatively you could look for a Mermaids UK class near you by visiting our website on www.mermaidsswimuk.co.uk
